Media models are similar to ICC profiles.

They contain color data very similar to ICC profiles. However, ICC profiles only contain color data numbers.

HP media profiles will incorporate the calculations for color, type of media being used, printing modes as well as other information critical for consistent printing.



The need for custom ICC profiles is not necessary for many clients using the PS versions of the designjet. Using the media models with the right paper and ink combination results in a very stable and consistent printing environment.

Media profiles are stored on the built-in RIP on the hp5000PS and hp5500PS.

They are activated by using the PostScript driver. Color fidelity and printing quality is taken care of by the printer.

Media profiles are available for the hp 5000ps and 5500ps designjet printers. They are available at the hp web site and can be downloaded and sent to the printer for many of the hp medias.
